Toronto - *Moving Still: City Emotional Architecture* is a photography exhibition by legendary Hong Kong-born singer-songwriter Yatfung, presented at The Rivoli from Aug 16 to Sep 6, 2026.

The exhibition gathers selected images organized around light, shadow, texture, city structures, nature, human stillness, perspective, and interior architecture. The work looks at the city as an emotional system rather than a backdrop. The photographs are quiet, architectural, and observational. They trace how cities hold solitude, memory, pressure, and movement - and how stillness can appear inside places that never stop moving.

ABOUT YATFUNG

Hong Kong-born singer-songwriter, photographer, producer, writer, and cultural curator, Yatfung 林一峰 has traveled to more than 80 countries and has lived in Spain, South Africa, Ireland, Myanmar, and across the U.S. over the years. Since his debut in 2003, he has released 25 solo albums in Mandarin, Cantonese, and English, written for major artists across Asia, and built an independent creative practice across music, photography, publishing, and live performance.

Moving Still is his English-language artistic chapter from Toronto, connecting songs, photographs, and intimate live experiences into one coherent cultural project.



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
